Preface 1.

In preparing this supplement to the Kilgour Report on the Resources for the Study of International Relations in Canadian Universities, the decision was made to include up-to-date information obtained since the original Report was issued, within the categories set out by that Report.

To obtain the necessary data, questionnaires were sent out to the Heads of Departments of Political Science and to the Deans of the relevant Faculties in Universities and Colleges across Canada. These requested the following information:

- 1. New degree and diploma courses available in the study of International Relations and in Area Studies; and new majors and honours programmes available in these fields within the various degree courses.
- 2. Additions, deletions, and corrections in course listings pertaining to the study of International Relations and Area Studies; including courses offered by the Department of Political Science, and any relevant courses offered by other departments of the University.
- Revisions of staff listings, to include new staff new fields of interest, and deletions from staff.
- 4. Additional information, to include plans and proposals, information on new committees and institutes, and on new library resources.
