- 3. The regular airborne equipment, as well as the materials and supplies normally retained on board the aircraft of a designated airline of either Contracting Party, may be unloaded in the territory of the other Contracting Party only with the approval of the customs authorities of that territory. In this case, they may be placed under the supervision of the customs authorities until they are re-exported or otherwise disposed of in accordance with the customs regulations applicable in that territory.
- 4. Each Contracting Party shall exempt baggage and cargo in direct transit across its territory from customs duties and other similar charges.

ARTICLE 8

Statistics

Each Contracting Party, through their aeronautical authorities, shall provide, or shall cause their designated airlines to provide to, the aeronautical authorities of the other Contracting Party, on request, periodic or other statements of statistics as may be reasonably required for the purpose of reviewing the operation of the agreed services, including statistics showing the initial origins and final destinations of the traffic.

ARTICLE 9

Tariffs

- 1. For the purposes of this Article,
 - a) "Tariff" means a publication which includes all rates, fares, charges, conditions of carriage, classifications, rules, regulations, practices and related services, for air transportation of passengers and their baggage and cargo but excludes remuneration and conditions for the carriage of mail;
 - b) "Price" means any fare, rate or charge contained in tariffs (including frequent flyer plans or other benefits provided in association with air transportation) for the carriage of passengers (including their baggage) and/or cargo (excluding mail) and the conditions directly governing the availability or applicability of such fare, rate or charge but excludes general terms and conditions of carriage;
 - c) "General Terms and Conditions of Carriage" means those terms and conditions contained in tariffs which are broadly applicable to the agreed services and not directly related to any price.
