THESE STUDENTS, SOME ACCOMPANIED BY THEIR FAMILIES, HAVE ALREADY BEGUN TO ARRIVE IN CANADA AND THE WORLD UNIVERSITY SERVICE HAS VOLUNTEERED TO MEET AND ASSIST THEM UPON ARRIVAL.

MR. GREEN SAID THAT HE WELCOMED THE UAR INITIATIVE IN SEEKING ADDITIONAL CULTURAL RELATIONS WITH WESTERN COUNTRIES, AND WAS MOST GRATIFIED THAT THE UAR REQUEST SHOULD HAVE BEEN MET SO PROMPTLY AND GENEROUSLY BY THE NCCUC AND CANADIAN UNIVERSITIES.
