

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Mitchell Sharp, announced today further details concerning the visit to Canada of Mr. Kurt Waldheim, Secretary-General of the United Nations.

Mr. Waldheim, accompanied by Mrs. Waldheim, will arrive at the Canadian Armed Forces Base, Uplands at 10:30 a.m. on Wednesday, May 24. Following his arrival, Mr. Waldheim will have talks with the Secretary of State for External Affairs and then be the guest of honour at a luncheon given by the Prime Minister, the Right Honourable Pierre Elliott Trudeau. After the luncheon, Mr. Waldheim and the Prime Minister will hold private talks. Following the private talks, Mr. Waldheim will proceed to the House of Commons to be recognized by the Speaker and sign the Speaker's Guest Book. Later in the afternoon, Mr. Waldheim will have a news conference and then proceed to Montreal, where he will be the guest of the United Nations Association of Canada and speak at their annual dinner.

On Thursday, May 25, Mr. Waldheim will visit the headquarters of the International Civil Aviation Organization. Following the ICAO visit, he will make a brief call on the Mayor of Montreal.

He will then return to Ottawa to attend the Carleton University convocation ceremonies and will be the Guest of Honour at the President's luncheon. Following the luncheon, Mr. Waldheim will receive an Honorary Degree and then address the Convocation.

Mr. Waldheim will leave Ottawa for New York at 4:30 p.m. on May 25.
