or pro honoris causa, or to limit the existing rights of any university or college.

This Act shall have full force and effect so long as the resolution set forth in the Schedule remains in full force. If at any time the Board of Governors of King's College, Windsor, shall rescind such resolution then this Act shall thereupon cease and determine.
