vate the British Nobility, and corrupt the lower Class of People; but may that noble Proclamation of our Royal Sovereign, for the Encouragement of Piety and Virtue, and for preventing and punishing of Vice, Profaneness, and Immorality; be held in due Reverence by every Class of People, as far as his Majesty's Dominions extend: May Peace, Content, and Happiness, be seen in every Eye, and selt in every Heart: May Commerce shourish, to increase our Wealth and extend our Territories: And may we become a happy and a glorious People, under a truly patriot King, is the earnest Prayer of Sir,
