

6th.—On the requisition of twenty-five of the enrolled Members, the President or Vice-President shall authorize the Secretary to call a Special General Meeting of the Association for the purpose or purposes set forth in the said requisition.

7th.—The Secretary shall give seven clear days notice of all Annual and Special General Meetings of Members both by advertisement in one or more of the public newspapers, and through the Post to the registered address of the Members on the books of the Association.

8th.—All notices of Special General Meetings shall state the business of the meeting, and at such meeting no other business than that stated in the notice shall be transacted.

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*Article VI.—Election of Officers.*

1st.—The President, Vice-President, Treasurer and five of the ten Directors shall be elected at each Annual General Meeting. Candidates nominated for said offices to be declared elected on receiving the highest number of votes. In case of a tie the President shall have a casting vote. Retiring officers and directors shall be eligible for re-election when nominated.

2nd.—When two or more candidates are nominated for any office a vote shall be taken, but if only one candidate be nominated he shall be declared elected.
