

## ARTICLE III.

## OFFICERS.

The affairs of the Society shall be managed by the officers of the Society, consisting of a Chief Factor, two Vice-Factors, an Honorary Treasurer, a Secretary-Treasurer, a Recording Secretary, an Inside Sentinel, an Outside Sentinel, and a Committee comprising five ordinary members. All of the Officers and Committee shall be elected annually by ballot, as provided by the by-laws of the Society.

## ARTICLE IV.

## AMENDMENTS.

Any amendments or alterations may be made to this constitution at any regular annual meeting by a vote of two-thirds of the members present at such meeting, provided that such amendment shall first be proposed at the monthly meeting of the Society previous to the said annual meeting, and at such meeting is carried by a two-thirds vote of the members present.
