second column give the number of days that each patient has remained in the hospital and for which the Government allows aid. If patient remains over 270 days in one hospital, the authorities must stand the expense, for the Government only allows 30 per day for 270 days.

The third column gives the total expenditure for maintenance. This includes such articles at meat, butter, eggs, flour, bread, meal, milk, tea, coffee, vegetables, drugs, light, gas, fuel, soap, brooms, water, ice, salaries and wages, insurance. It is really the entire expenditure incurred by the hospital in caring for the patients during the year. Thus, in the Toronto General Hospital there were 2,666 patients who stayed 78,652

days at a cost of \$69,555, or 85 1-2 cents per head per day. The Homeopathic, Toronto, costs 85.67 per head per day, and the Hospital for Sick Children 76.24 per head per day, or 76 1-4 cents.

These three institutions are examples

of well managed and economically governed establishments, and will bear most favourable comparison with similar in-stitutions in the United States and Great

Britain.

The public have an idea that when maintenance is spoken of in connection with hospital work that the term applies only to the food used in a building. The term maintenance, however, is used as applying to every item of expenditure in connection with the carrying on of hospital work.
