THE WAR NEWS

German airships raided the county of Norfolk, England, last night and dropped bombs at half a dozen different points, including the vicinity of the Royal Palace at Sandringham. A few persons were killed and some property was damaged by this raid, which is quite in line with the barbaric methods of the Germans.

The British government has rejected the American proposal that the steamship Daedalus, bought from the Hamburg-American line, but believed to be still remaining in German hands, should be permitted to carry a cargo of cotton to Germany.

HELPING THE BELGIANS
