Reviews of Year--Boxing

NEW YORK, Dec. 30.—While the brains, competition and the class of the competitors in practically every American sport increased in 1925, professional boxing went back. Five of the best American fighters in the major classes retired from activity and only two developed enough to be considered worthy successors. Jack Dempsey, the world's heavyweight champion, spent the entire year out of the ring and kept repeating his intention to accept the challenge of Harry Wills. Benny Leonard retired as the lightweight champion, saying that he was obliged to comply with the wishes of his mother who didn't like his profession. Johnny Dundee retired as the featherweight champion, admitting that he could no longer make the weight. Pancho Villa, the little flyweight champion from the Philippines, died on an operating table in San Francisco. Tom Gibbons, for years one of the outstanding heavyweights, fell so far off form that he was knocked out for the first time in his career by Gene Tunney.

Succeeding Leonard, Dundee and Villa, three great champions, were Jimmy Goodrich and Rocky Kansas in the lightweight class; Kid Kaplan in the featherweight division and Fidel LaBarba as the featherweight champion. When Leonard resigned the New York Boxing Commission decided upon an elimination tournament among the contenders to find a new champion. Goodrich survived the tournament and was recognized as the new champion. Critics expressed the opinion, however, that he would lose the championship the first time he had to defend it and he did. Rocky Kansas, 33 years old and a veteran of 15 campaigns, won the title after a tough bout with Goodrich and now holds the crown. Kansas always has been a

great little fighter of a hard battling school but he is past his best days. Sanny Marini, one of the good youngsters developed in 1925, is the outstanding challenger for the lightweight championship.

The same plan of finding the successor to Dundee was followed by the boxing commission and the survivor of the tournament, Kid Kaplan, was recognized as the featherweight champion. Kaplan had two major fights in defense of his title, both against Babe Herman, the California challenger. The first fight took place in Waterbury and was called a draw, although the majority of the critics thought that Herman had won. The second, staged recently in Tex Rickard's Garden, was a terrible affair in which Kaplan won the decision. With the exception of Herman, there is not an outstanding featherweight in the class. Fidel LaBarba, a product of the 1924 American Olympic team, won the flyweight championship when he defeated Frankie Genaro in California. When Pancho Villa died, the commission decided against a tournament as there were so few challengers and Genaro, the American champion, was unofficially accepted as the challenger. The New York Commission does not recognize LaBarba as the champion because he did not win the decision in a 15-round fight and is under age.

Another fighter who developed greatly in 1925 was Paul Berlenbach, the new world's light heavyweight champion. Berlenbach pulled a big surprise by defeating Mike McTigue on points and taking a 15-round decision and the title. In defending his title, Berlenbach recently outpointed Jack Delaney, who had knocked him out when he was just getting started. Booring as a game improved greatly in 1925 under the supervision of the New York Boxing Commission, guided ably

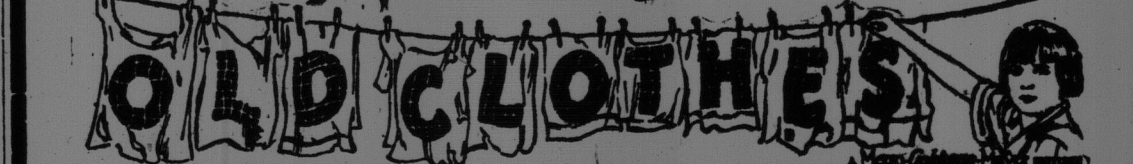
