## ACTS AND PROCEEDINGS

OF THE

Synod of the Presbyterian Church of Canada, in connection with the Church of Scotland, Session XVII, held at Kingston, July 8, 1846.

## DIET I.

At Kingston, and within St. Andrew's Church there:—
Wednesday, the Eighth Day of July, One Thousand
Eight Hundred and Forty-Six Years:—

The which day, after sermon by the Rev. William Bell, of Perth, the Moderator of the Synod for the preceding year, from Hebrews xiii. 17, "They watch for your souls, as they that must give account," the Synod of the Presbyterian Church of Canada, in connection with the Church of Scotland, met, according to appointment, and was constituted with prayer by the Moderator.

Presbytery Rolls having been given in, the Synod Roll was made up and read over.

The Synod next proceeded to the election of two Trustees for Queen's College, at Kingston, in room of the two who retired from office at this time, according to the terms of the Royal Charter of Queen's College, when the Rev. Robert McGill, and the Rev. James Williamson were elected, and the Clerk was instructed to intimate the same to the Board of Trustees.
