The English course, omitting the Latin and French languages, will embrace three years.

GERMAN COURSE. 1st Year,—*Tiark's German Grammar, Heydenrich's German Reader.* 2nd Year,—*Tiark's Grammar, Adler's Progressive Reader.* 3rd Year,—*Adler's Handbook of German Literature, History of German Literature.* 4th Year,—*Schiller, (Maria Stuart), Goethe, (Iphigénie,) History of German Literature.*

ITALIAN COURSE. 1st Year,—*De Porquet's Italian Grammar, De Porquet's Il Tesoretto.* 2nd Year,—*"La Rosa dell' Alpi," "La Fiera," "Francesca da Rimini."* 3rd Year,—*Tasso, Pellico.* 4th Year,—*Dante, Petrarca, Alfieri.*

This course will correspond to the collegiate and either of these languages will be considered equivalent for the Latin.
