ELLIOTT Reg. No. 24587, Sgt. Raymond Maxwell Elliott, 54, died August 19, 1996, at Orléans, Ontario. He was born April 28, 1942, at St. Anthony, Newfoundland, and joined the Force February 24, 1966, at Corner Brook. Upon completion of training at "Depot", Elliott was posted to "A" Division, Ontario, and served at Ottawa and Pembroke. He was subsequently transferred to the following locations: August 27, 1971, to "L" Division, Prince Edward Island, at Cavendish and Charlottetown; August 19, 1979, to "G" Division, Northwest Territories, at Yellowknife; June 23, 1986, to HQ, where he was still serving at the time of his death. Elliott was promoted to corporal November 20, 1979; sergeant October 1, 1982.

GAULIN Reg. No. 15531, ex-Cst. Joseph Alfred René Gaulin, 73, died April 26, 1996, at Toronto. He was born March 15, 1923, at Quebec City, where he joined the Force September 11, 1948. Upon completion of training at "Depot" and "N" Divisions, Gaulin was posted to "C" Division, Quebec, where he served at Montréal and Quebec City, taking his discharge October 10, 1953.

GILBERTSON Reg. No. 16004, ex-Cst. Larry Henry Gilbertson, 64, died April 7, 1996, at Vernon, British Columbia. He was born October 4, 1931, at Saskatoon, and joined the Force December 2, 1948, at Regina. Upon completion of training at "Depot" and "N" Divisions, Gilbertson was posted to "D" Division, Manitoba, where he served at Winnipeg, Charleswood, Carman, Selkirk, Kenora, Tuxedo and Morris, taking his discharge February 1, 1956.

GOOD Reg. No. C/144, ex-C/M Edward Hart Good, 76, died August 3, 1996, at Edmonton. He was born February 15, 1920, at Fillmore, Saskatchewan, and joined the Force as a civilian employee at Regina, February 22, 1951. Good was posted to "F" Division, Saskatchewan, where he worked at Regina and Swift Current, and became a civilian member April 1, 1960. On January 1, 1966, he was transferred to "K" Division, Alberta, and worked at Edmonton until retiring February 15, 1980.

GURNEY Reg. No. 17780 (S/10489), ex-Cpl. Thomas Broughton Gurney, 88, died September 17, 1996, at Comox, British Columbia. He was born December 3, 1905, at Nanaimo, where he joined the Force as a special constable August 15, 1950, upon the amalgamation with the BCPP, where he had worked since January 1949. Gurney was posted to "E" Division, British Columbia, namely at Marine Division. On May 1, 1952, he converted to regular member status and continued to serve in Marine Division, namely at Port Alberni and Ocean Falls, retiring October 9, 1956. He was promoted to corporal May 1, 1952.

HANNAH Reg. No. 13194, ex-Cst. Ralph Norman James Hannah, 82, died December 30, 1995, at Toronto, where he was born January 8, 1913, and joined the Force October 16, 1939. Upon completion of training at "Depot" Division, Hannah was posted to "H" Division, Nova Scotia, where he served at Halifax, Sydney, Port Hawkesbury, Inverness, New Waterford and Glace Bay, taking his discharge September 13, 1944.

HARRIS Reg. No. 15164, ex-S/Sgt. Percy Borden Harris, 66, died September 5, 1995, at Mississauga, Ontario. He was born May 23, 1930, at Malden, Massachusetts, and joined the Force August 24, 1948, at Halifax. Upon completion of training at "Depot", Harris was posted to "O" Division, Ontario, where he worked at Sudbury and Toronto. On May 1, 1960, he was transferred to HQ, Ottawa, and retired on January 26, 1974. Harris was promoted to corporal June 1, 1960; sergeant April 1, 1966; staff sergeant April 1, 1968.

HENDERICKX Reg. No. S/586, ex-S/Cst. Constant Hendrickx, 68, died July 27, 1996, at Penticton, British Columbia. He was born May 30, 1928, at Hoboken, Belgium, and joined the Force as a special constable February 15, 1972, at Edmonton, Alberta. He was posted to "A" Division, Ontario, namely on Parliament Hill in Ottawa as the explosives and bomb disposal expert. S/Cst. Hendrickx retired May 29, 1984.

HOLMES Reg. No. 8389, ex-Cst. William Norman Holmes, 94, died November 28, 1995, at Duncan, British Columbia. He was born in May 1901, joined the Force in 1919, at Regina and took his discharge in 1924.

LAVENTURE Reg. No. 13100, ex-Cst. Hilton Andrews Laventure, died August 10, 1996. He was born January 31, 1915, at Asquith, Saskatchewan, and joined the Force November 28, 1938, at Ottawa. Upon completion of training at "Depot" and "N" Divisions, Laventure was posted to "J" Division, New Brunswick, where he served at Fredericton, Moncton and Newcastle, taking his discharge January 31, 1943.

LECOCQ Reg. No. 15925, ex-Sgt. Alfred Renouf Lecocq, 66, died September 13, 1996, at Dalhousie, New Brunswick. He was born April 21, 1930, at Cape Cove, Gaspé and joined the Force September 29, 1949, at Montréal. Upon completion of training at "Depot" and "N" Divisions, Lecocq was posted to "J" Division, New Brunswick, where he served at Fredericton, Moncton, Campbellton, Bathurst, Sackville, Shediac, Tabusintac, Shippegan and Richibucto, retiring September 28, 1969. Lecocq was promoted to corporal May 1, 1956; sergeant November 1, 1964; staff sergeant November 1, 1966.

LOUVELLE Reg. No. M/130 (S/11125), ex- M/Cst. Gerald Louvelle, 65, died October 2, 1996, at Halifax. He was born January 29, 1931, at St. George, Newfoundland, and joined the Force as a special constable on January 14, 1959, at St. John's. Louvelle was posted to "H" Division, Nova Scotia, namely at
