The monthly subscription is four cents, by mail five cents, for this weekly is a cent publication. It is printed in eight columns, each 4½ inches long and 1½ inches wide, on thick manilla paper. And yet the staff includes an editor and director an administrator, or business manager, a responsible man or capitalist, and a printer. Among newspapers this tiny Sunday journal certainly occupies a unique position.—*San Francisco Call.*
