CALDWELL, WILLIAM CLYDE, B.A. (*North Lanark.*)

B. at Lanark, Ont., May 1843. Ed. there, and graduated at Queen's University, Kingston, 1865. First returned to Parlt. for North Lanark in 1872. An unsuccessful candidate for same seat at g.e. 1875; again returned at last g.e. A Liberal.—*Lanark, Ont.*

CALVIN, DELINO DEXTER. (*Frontenac.*)

B. in the State of New York, at commencement of present century. M. Miss Wilkinson, of Kingston. A mem. of the extensive firm of Calvin & Co., Garden Island, lumber merchants, forwarders and shipowners. Has been Reeve of Garden Island and Warden of Frontenac. Sat in the Local Legislature of Ont. for present constituency from 1868 to 1874, when he retired. Was a mem. of the Canal Commission, 1870. Again returned to Parlt. upon decease of sitting mem., Mr. Graham, Feb. 1877; re-elected at last g.e. A Conservative.—*Kingston, Ont.*

CASCADEN, JOHN, M.D. (*West Elgin.*)

Fourth s. of David and Mary A. Cascaden, of Ballyshannon, Co. Donegal, Irel., who emigrated to Can. in 1852, eventually settling in Co. Bruce, Ont. B. in Ballyshannon, Co. Donegal, Irel., 3 Dec. 1840. Ed. in Toronto and London, Eng. M., 1st, Catharine, dau. of James Ferguson, Southwold, Ont., 29 Nov. 1860 (she d.); 2nd, H. Catherine, dau. of Daniel Deacon, Esq., Iona, 13 Nov. 1872. Received the degree of Doctor of Medicine from Toronto University in 1863; enrolled a mem. of the Royal College of Surgeons, Eng., in 1867; became a Licentiate of the Royal College of Physicians, London, Eng., and of the Royal College of Physicians, Edinburgh, in the same year. Held the office of Coroner until his nomination for Parlt. Was Presdt. of the West Elgin Reform Assn. First returned to Parlt. at last g.e. A Liberal, and opposed to Protection and a National Currency.—*Iona, Ont.*

CHISHOLM, KENNETH. (*Peel.*)

Descended from an old Highland family, originally from Inverness-shire. B. and ed. in the Co. of Peel. A merchant. Held the
