Eld. s. of Duncan Clarke, Esq., late of Oro, in the Co. of Simcoe, formerly of Argyleshire, Scot. B. in the City of Londonderry, Irel., 23 July, 1838. Called to the Bar U. C., in Hilary Term, 1866. Was Mayor of Prescott in 1866-7. First returned to Parlt. at last g. e. Pop., 13,695. No. of voters, 1,974.—*Prescott, Ont.*
