1. Waits on His Excellency, with the House, in the Senate Chamber, at the opening of the Session, 1. At the close, 365.
2. Reports His Excellency's Speech from the Throne at the opening of the Session, 52.
3. Communicates to the House the Report of the Librarian, 54. The account current of the Accountant of the House, 364. Other Papers and Returns, 60, 89, etc.
4. Informs the House that he had received from the Judges selected for the trial of Election Petitions, certificates and reports relating to the Elections, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, etc.
