

Special constables may be appointed by one Justice under Con. Stat. con. cap. 104.

V. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in chapter 104 of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada, any one Justice of the Peace may, in Upper Canada, appoint special Constables in any case in which, by virtue of the said chapter, such appointment may be made by any two or more Justices of the Peace, and the provisions of the said Act shall apply to and with respect to such appointment by any one Justice in like manner, as to appointments made by two Justices. 5

Act limited to U. C.

VI. This Act shall apply only to Upper Canada.
