Any offender who shall not forthwith pay the fine Imprisonment 22. and costs he may have been condemned to pay, shall be com- ment of fine. mitted to Gaol for a term of not less than one month, nor more than six months, at the discretion of the Magistrate before whom the offender may have been convicted.

23. Every penalty or forfeiture imposed by this Act or Recovery of the regulations to be made under it, may be recovered on complaint before the Superintendent of fisheries, or any Stipendiary or other Magistrate, in a summary manner, and the proceedings and the costs to be recovered shall be the same as is provided by law in either Section of the Province in other cases where summary jurisdiction is given to Magistrates.

24. Each Inspector of Fish shall annually, on or before the Annual returns by inspectors. first day of January in each year, make a return to the Commissioner of Public Lands or to the Superintendent of Fisheries, shewing the quantity of fish inspected by him, and the names of the owners of the said fish, together with the quality and species thereof respectively.
