## C A P. XXXVII.

An Act to amend an Act of the Twenty-eighth Year of His present Majesty, for allowing the Importation of Rum or other Spirits from His Majesty's Colonies or Plantations in the West Indies, into the Province of Quebec, without Payment of Duty.

[15th April 1813.]

THEREAS it is expedient to amend an Act passed in the Twentyeighth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled An 28 G.3. c.39. Act to allow the Importation of Rum or other Spirits from His Majesty's Colonies or Plantations in the West Indies into the Province of Quebec, without Payment of Duty, under certain Conditions and Restrictions; be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this Valuations of present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That Rum and Cargoes from and after the First Day of September One thousand eight hundred under recited and thirteen, the Value of the Rum or other Spirits admitted to an Entry A& shall, under the faid Act, and the Value of the Cargo of Lumber or Provisions, from Sept. 1, Horses or Neat Cattle loaded in the said Province under the said Act, somputed acfinal respectively be estimated and computed according to the Valuations cording to contained in the Schedule annexed to this Act.

II. Provided always, and be it further enacted, That it shall and may Privy Council be lawful for His Majesty, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, may alter such by Order or Orders to be iffued and published from Time to Time, to alter the Valuations and Articles contained in the faid Schedule whenever it shall appear necessary or proper upon any Representation or Report made by the Governor and Council of the faid Province.
