CAP. XI.

An Act to permit, until the First Day of October One thousand eight hundred and one, the Importation of Herrings and other Fish, the Produce of the Fishery carried on in Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Newfoundland, and on the Coast of Labrador, into this Kingdom, without Payment of 15th December 1800.] Duty.

THEREAS it is expedient, under the present Circumstances, Preamble. to permit, for a limited Time, the Importation of Herrings and other Fish, the Produce of the Fishery carried on in Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Newfoundland, and on the Coast of Labrador, into Great Britain, in British-built Ships, owned, navigated, and registered according to Law, without Payment of Duty; be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That, from and after the passing of this Act, it shall and may be lawful Herrings and other Fish to and for any Person or Persons whatever, to import into Great Britain may be imfrom Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Newfoundland, and from the Coast ported from Nova Scotia, in any British-built Ship, owned, navigated, and registered etc in British-according to Law, any Herrings or other Fish, the Produce of the said built Vessels, without Payment of Duty.
