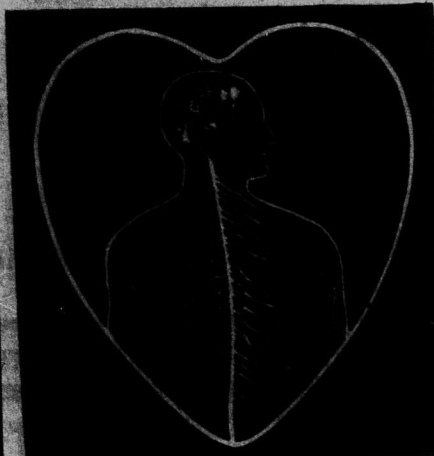

No. 1.—DOUBLE BEHEADINGS.

9. Doubly behead a word meaning to wrinkle the brows, as in frowning, and get a word meaning a bird.
10. Doubly behead a word meaning the land belonging to a nobleman and get a conjunction.

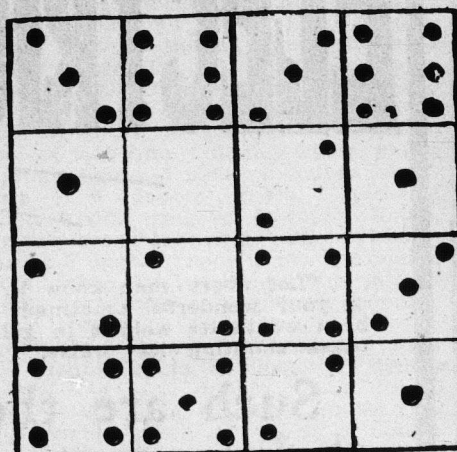

No. 6.—MAGIC DOMINO PUZZLE.

Eight dominoes placed together form a square of sixteen half-dominoes, as shown in the illustration above. But, in the illustration, each row of four half-dominoes contains a different number of spots from any of the other rows. Thus the topmost row, counting horizontally, contains eighteen spots; the



one below it only four; the first row to the left counting vertically, ten; the diagonal row, downward from left to right, eight, etc. It is required to place these same eight dominoes in such a square that each row of half dominoes, whether counted horizontally, vertically or diagonally, will contain exactly sixteen spots.

No. 7.—PROBLEM.

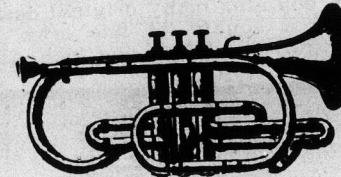
