#### POINTS TO REMEMBER

1. Names of all delegates, together with name of institution represented, should reach the New York office, with the program fee, not later than June 20. Those whose fees are received much earlier than this date, can receive better assignments.
2. All remittances should be sent by New York draft, post office or express money order or registered letter, not by currency in unregistered letter. All remittances should be drawn in favor of Northfield Student Conference.
3. Delegates to the College Conference should arrive in time to attend the opening meeting, which will be held in the Auditorium at 8.00 o'clock, Friday evening, June 25. Preparatory School delegates should be present for their first meeting at 5.00 P.M., June 28th. All should plan to remain until the close of the Conference, Sunday evening, July 4.
4. A special meal will be served in Marquand Hall at noon on Friday, June 25, to accommodate those who arrive during that morning. For this an extra charge of fifty cents will be made. The regular meals of the conference begin with supper, Friday evening.
5. Mail for delegates should be addressed to Student Conference, East Northfield, Mass., in care of the college delegation.
