JULY 24th

Organizer Summerhayes writes; " Conferred with President Colin McIntosh and he will personally attend to the Carleton Place lists and perhaps Almonte. He undertakes that every Municipality list is properly revised. Lanark Village and Lavant Township lists are posted. He thinks re-distribution will make one Lanark. McIntosh thinks that Thomas B. Caldwell ex M.P. would consent to be Dominion Candidate again.

North and South Lanark may be merged into one riding. Joint census population 34,375.

LANARK SOUTH July 12th and 13th, 1912
