Rev. Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 4th instant, enclosing an estimate of the cost of material to erect two tent houses to be used as dormitories in connection with the Coqualeetza Industrial School, amounting in all to \$150.00 for each tent.

In reply I beg to say that the Department approves of your suggestion that these tents if erected should be 40 by 22 or 24 with a 10 or 12 foot studding; 4 windows instead of 2 and a brick chimney, all to be painted in harmony with the other buildings of the Institution.

The Department will be prepared to pay for material for a tent of the description given in your estimate, with the changes above mentioned, to the extent of \$200.00 for each. The erection of these tents should be proceeded with at once so that the accounts may be forwarded to the Department and paid for during the present fiscal year. It is to be distinctly understood that the Department will not be asked to pay for any material in excess of the amount mentioned.
