At a meeting of the Saskatchewan members of the Canadian Seed Growers' Association, held in Saskatoon on September 6, the question of marketing the registered seed produced was discussed. The majority of the members appeared to be of the opinion that a co-operative marketing association was desirable to handle members' grain. It was pointed out that such an organization could insure uniformity in quality by operating a central cleaning plant and could advertise the product of the producers much more economically than could each man individually. L. H. Newman, secretary of the C.S.G.A., explained how the members of the association in Quebec were conducting such a selling agency.
