Mr. Hinsbelwood, from the Committee appoint-, Poor Bill amended, ed Yesterday, to confer with the Committee of His Majesty's Council, upon the Amendments proposed to be made to the Act in Addition to an Act relating to the Maintenance of the Poor, Reported, that the Committee had agreed to some Alteration of the Amendments proposed, and the House having refumed the Confideration thereof, agreed to the Bill with fome Amendments, and Ordered the fame to be engroffed, and fent up to his Majesty's and sent to the Council.

The House then took into Consideration a Bill in Addition to the Act relating to Treasons and Fe- Act relating to lonies, which was read; whereupon they Refolved, lonies, that a Message be sent to his Majesty's Council, to defire they would appoint a Committee to join a Committee of the House to confer upon the sub- committee of Conject Matter of the faid Bill, and of an additional Clause to be made thereto.

The House also took under Consideration the Bill, intituled An Act for granting to his Majesty Bill for laving a Duty on Wheela Duty on Wheel Carriages within the Peninsula of Carriages, Halifax, which being read, was Ordered to be committed, whereupon the House resolved itself into a Committee of the whole House, and having fpent some Time therein, Mr. Tonge, from the Committee, reported, that the House had gone thro' the faid Bill, and had agreed to the fame with fint to the Council.
