various Faculties and Colleges, by his assistants in the Roll of Service office, who were graduates of the University and gave devoted and unremitting care to their work, by the ex-service men themselves in answering enquiries about themselves and giving or obtaining information about others, and by the relatives and friends of the Fallen in giving the details on which the brief memorial accounts are based. Without the willing help of all these this work could not have been brought to completion. At best it can be but an imperfect record of the services rendered by nearly 6,000 sons of the University, but despite all defects may it be held as pietate operis excusatus.
