

DESTRUCTION IN DARDANELLES.

A despatch from Athens says the Turks lost 250 men and two guns, destroyed in the bombardment of the forts of the Dardanelles. The former German cruisers Goeben and Breslau, which are now flying the Turkish flag, have re-entered the Bosphorus.

MONUMENT TO LORD ROBERTS.

LONDON, To-Day In order that no time should be lost n providing a suitable memorial for Lord Roberts, Premier Asquith will move in the Commons that an address pe presented to King George, asking the King's directions that a monument be erected at public cost with an in scription on it, expressing the admir ation of this House for his illustrious military career and its gratitude for his devoted services to the State.

LONDON, To-Day. The greatest single demand made upon the material resources of Britain was voiced by Premier Asquith yesterday afternoon when in the Commons he moved an additional credit for war purposes of \$1,125,000,000, which in addition to the millions already voted in August is equivalent to an increase of more than 50 per cent to the national debt. The Premier told the House that the largest portion of the first £100,000,000 had eady been expended in the conduct military operations, loans to allies, isbursements for securing food supplies for this country, expenditure for sugar, which has been especially rge and would, in the belief of the Premier, ultimately be recouped by the Exchequer. A considerable sum will be spent to secure control of the of this would be for army and navy expenditure. The Premier said the civil expenditures would be inconsiderable. They would be largely for the sicken. purpose of securing food supplies and for further commodities necessary for British use which must be made impossible for the enemy. Another large item was made up in loans of money others, amounting to £43,000,000. The principal item in this list would be to the Belgian Government, £10,000,-000, and Servia, £800,000, on which interest was to be charged until the end of the war. Other loans to self-governing Dominions — Canada, South Africa, Australia, New Zealand, countries which under ordinary cirumstances would be compelled to rrow in the London market-would had undertaken the responsibility of raising loans for these Dominions. Regarding the cost of the war, As-

quith said he declined to delve into the future or speculate what commit-ments it might be necessary for Britments it might be necessary for Brit-ain later, but up to last Saturday the actual additional expenditure falling upon the Exchequer amounted to be-tween £900,000 and £1,000,000 a day, Having regard to the enormous scale. of the operations and other considerations, this sum, the Premier said, did not exceed the estimates of expendiure that might reasonably have been expected. Continuing, the Premier said he would hold out no hope that these expenditures would likely be liminished. Replying to the criticism of the news raised in the course of debate, Asquith declared nothing had been kept back except in cases where such a course was required by immediate military exigencies. Touching on other points raised in the course of debate, Asquint said increased exports to neutral countries were in most cases due to the fact that the supply to these countries from Germany had been cut off rather than to the fact that goods were being re-exported by those countries to Germany Dealing with the Miss N. K. Payne Premier remarked that apart from the Stewart Torrayille Premier remarked that apart from the territorials 1,100,000 men were already under arms. That number, however, he added was not enough. He said he saw no reason to be discouraged by the recruiting figures. The number of men the exigencies of the country demanded, he believed, would be raised. Indeed he considered the recruiting position was very satisfactory.
