PUBLIC NOTICE!

Intoxicating Liquors!

From and after the first day of January, 1917, no persons except the Controller appointed under the provisions of the Prohibition Plebiscite Act, 1915, shall import into the Colony any intoxicating liquors, except for sacramental purposes, under a penalty of not less than one hundred dollars, and not exceeding five hundred dollars, or, in default of payment, imprisonment not exceeding three months. If any one after the first day of January, 1917, manufactures any intoxicating liquors at any place within the Colony he shall be liable to a penalty of not less than one hundred dollars, and not exceeding five hundred dollars, or, in default of payment, imprisonment not exceeding three months. If any one not licensed in accordance with the provisions of the said Prohibition Plebiscite Act (Druggists and Medical Practitioners) sells, after the 1st day of January, 1917, any intoxicating liquors, he shall be liable to a penalty of not less than one hundred dollars, and not exceeding five hundred dollars, or, in default of payment, imprisonment not exceeding three months. If any one has in his possession any intoxicating liquors at any place in the Colony after the first day of January, 1917, manufactured or imported in or into the Colony after the first day of January, 1917, except in accordance with the provisions of section 27 of the Prohibition Plebiscite Act, 1915, he shall be liable to a penalty of not less than one hundred dollars, or, in default of payment, imprisonment not exceeding three months.
