The British American Claims Com-

It has been announced that as a late hour on Weloneday night the British American Claims Commission, organized under the 12th article of the Washing-ton Treaty, for the adjudication of the British and American claims, other than the Alabama claims, concluded its busi-ness. The Commission first met at Washington on the 26th September, 1971, and during their sessions times that period have had under considera-tion four hundred and seventy-eight claims of British subjects against the United States, and nineteen claims of citizens of the United States against Great British subjects against the United States, and nineteen claims of citizens of the United States against Great British the latter class of claims-that is, those made by the citi-zens of the United States against British—have been dissilowed, while of the former sufficient have been found valid to foot up a bill of awards against the United States to the extent of \$2,-500,000. The nineteen United States claims referred to wore for losses said to have been inflicted by the St. Albans raid, and by the detention of some ships at Calcutta, which had been loading with salipetre. 
