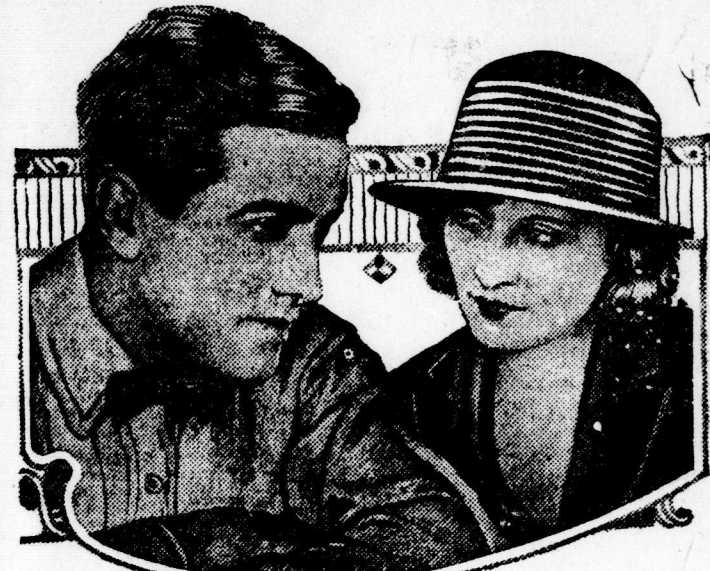
Bolsheviki Used Names of Men As Bait For American Aid.
