Nova Scotia Temperance Act Accounts and Inspector's Report. To the Warden and Councillors of the Municipality of Annapolis Co. Gentlemen: I beg to present the record of my work during the past year, as Inspector for the enforcement of the Nova Scotia Temperance Act.

In the process of the year's work, I have travelled 685 miles and have written 40 letters. The manufacture and sale of home brewed beer prevails extensively in some parts of Annapolis West, and is likely to increase (unless checked) under the new conditions produced by recent Order in Council and fore-shadowed legislation.
