Mercantile Summary.

LUMBER is accumulating very rapidly on the government pier at St. John, N.B., says the *Sun*. There are now about 140 cars loaded with deals on the pier awaiting shipment to Europe. These cars contain somewhere in the vicinity of one and one-half millions of lumber.

THERE arrived at St. John, N.B., on Sunday last, the "Abbie S. Hart," the first Montreal sugar ship of the season. She brings 2,000 tons. Last year the C. P. R. began the work of forwarding raw sugar to Montreal from there. This autumn the company made arrangements to handle a large number of cargoes.

LET'S go and live at Dunnville, or Kingsville, this winter. The former town is now supplied with natural gas, and coal and wood for heating purposes have been driven entirely out of use. As at Kingsville, gas for stoves is supplied for \$1 to \$2 a month, and as there is no limit to the length of piping, one stove can be made to heat a good sized house. Perhaps Warton would suit us better. The *News* of that place says, "With ripe raspberries being gathered at the roadsides and wild strawberries in blossom on the 15th of November, people are beginning to wonder really what is coming over the Bruce peninsula"—which is not infrequently covered with snow at this time of year.
