Amended Regulations.

Regulation 38.—Application for admission to the Normal School Entrance Examinations should be addressed to the Inspector within whose Inspectorial District the candidate wishes to write, not later than the 24th day of May, in each year. The application shall state the class for which the candidate with the ca didate wishes to enter and the station at which he wishes to be examined. An examination fee of \$2.00 must accompany each application. For applications received after May 24th an additional fee of \$1.00 must be paid. For transferring the name of a candidate from one station to another, a fee of \$1.00 will be charged.

Regulation 45.—Every person who purposes to present himself at the Leaving Examination, or at the Matriculation Examination, shall send to ector within whose Inspectorial District he intends to write, not later than the 24th of May preceding, an application upon the form provided for the purpose, stating the class of certificate for which he is a candidate, and what optional subject or subjects he has selected. Such notice shall be accompanied by a fee of \$3. If the application is received after May 24th an additional fee of \$1 must be paid. For transferring the name of a candidate from one station to another, a fee of \$1 will be charged.
