Protocol left open to Countries represented for signature and accession.

The Protocol remains open to those countries whose representatives have signed only the Convention or only a certain number of the Agreements drawn up by the Congress in order to permit them to accede to the Convention or to one or other of them.

XVI

Period for the notification of accessions.

The accessions referred to in Articles XVI and XV must be notified diplomatically by the respective Governments to the Government of the French Republic and by it to the other States of the Union. The period allowed for this is to be fixed by the Congress.

DECLARATION MADE AT THE TIME OF SIGNATURE, UNDER ARTICLE 9 OF THE CONVENTION, RELATING TO THE APPLICATION OF THE CONVENTION TO COLONIES, PROTECTORATES, ETC.

The delegation of the Union of South Africa declares that its acceptance of the present Convention includes the Mandated Territory of South West Africa.

Protocol left open to Countries not represented.

The Protocol remains open to the countries of the Union not represented at the Congress in order to permit them to accede to the Convention and the Agreements there concluded, or only to one or other of them.
