

- (5) free primary and secondary schooling, and tertiary schooling with the payment of Canadian, instead of foreign, student fees; and,
- (6) the free issuance of provincial hunting and fishing licences.

The Office of Protocol interprets immunities as protections from law enforcement that the Canadian Government is obliged by law to grant.

Without prejudice to their privileges, benefits, and immunities, the Canadian Government expects all members of diplomatic and consular missions in Canada to respect Canadian laws and regulations in accordance with their duty under the Vienna Conventions.
