### **Narcotics, Controlled Drugs and Precursors**

7. In addition to the illicit drug precursors items identified in Group 8, which are controlled pursuant to international agreements, Health Canada also controls, by regulation under the *Controlled Drugs and Substances Act*, certain drugs, controlled substances, and precursors.

## **F. What Are The Export Permit Requirements For Forest Products?**

1. A variety of export controls apply to Canadian forest products listed in Group 5 of the ECL. Remember that most Group 5 Items, including forest products, require a \$14 processing fee (softwood lumber's processing fee is \$9) for each export permit application. The following explains how exporters may obtain a permit to export a controlled forest product.
