

MILITARY INSTRUCTION

UNIVERSITY of TORONTO.

Course covers three years, beginning in second year

Students must have had some previous military training.

Time required by academic part of course.

Second year - 2 hours per week

Third and fourth years - 3 hours per week

Subjects covered in course

a. Professional subjects comprising the work required for the C.O.T.C. certificates "A" and "B".

b. Lectures on citizenship, relations between the various parts of the Empire with regard to defence, trade-routes, coal and fuel stations, naval power, and the distribution of the Empire's armed forces.

Credit towards degree.

May be chosen as an elective course counting towards a degree.

Practical Work.
