I visited the Practice School which consists of all grades from 1 - 11, although there are but ten teachers including the Principal, Mr. Cook. I wonder how good he is. In this connection I gathered the impression that a little too much red tape existed between the Bursar's Office and Mr. Stevens, who has charge of the Repair Department.
