Dr. Cameron is a native of Glasgow, where he was born in 1894. He was educated at Allan Glen's School, the Universities of Glasgow, Edinburgh and London, and the Royal Veterinary College. He now has the degrees of M.A., B.Sc., Ph.D., D.Sc. and M.R.C.V.S.; after post-graduate work he obtained further experience in the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine and at the Institute of Agricultural Parasitology, with both of which he was connected from 1923 to 1929.

He comes to McGill from Edinburgh where he was lecturer in helminthology, as well as being connected with the Royal Veterinary College, 1929-32. He has held many positions of importance in medical and helminthological associations and he has written over sixty papers on helminthology and veterinary parasitology.
