If desired, in place of putting the reception at foot of invitation, it is correct form to send a separate card, enclosed with the others, reading thus:

> Mr. and Mrs. Charles E. Evans request the pleasure of your presence On Wednesday Evening, June thirteenth, at half past eight o'clock, 808 Sherbrooke Street.

When the wedding is quiet at home, followed by a reception in the evening, the invitation is worded thus:

Mr. and Mrs. Charles E. Evans request your presence at the wedding reception of their daughter, Dorothy May, and Mr. Ernest A. Morrison, On Wednesday evening, June thirteenth, Nineteen hundred and three. at eight o'clock. 808 Sherbrooke Street, Montreal.
