13721stated that what they wanted was a Reserve adjoining and to the West--ward of that of lund. Kow. en per ting on the In appelle Sliver, as they require -ed land with running water through it wherein fish could be found. as the odd sections, except the School sections of this land, are owned by the Morte west fand bourpany, the Chief was reformed that the idea of obtain - ing a deserve where he desired in the valley was almost impracticable but still at his solicitation a promise was made time, that this office would Communicate with the bepartment on the subject.

I believe it would be advantageous to the Assimitoine Indians of the Reserve adjoining Fia-pots if the latter Chief were allowed to remove from trispres. - ent location, but his young men who are a bad lot will for sometime to come be more or less restless and consequently be a distincing element wherever they are.

The Land boundary ungles if the Department should consider it desirate
