DOUBLE-SHIFT EDUCATION.

(Toronto Globe.)

Under the above title The Times-Journal of Fort William discusses the plan recently adopted by the Board of Education of Halleybury, whereby the lower school forms in two shifts, viz. eight a.m. to 12 noon, and one to five p.m. This decision is due to lack of room and the influx of students. The Times-Journal goes on to point out that the building and equipment of our schools run into heavy capital expenditure, and there is probably not another class of building, designed for public use, with the exception of our churches, which is used for as short a space of time as our school buildings. Out of the 8,700 hours of the year the average school is only used for 1,100 hours, or one-eighth of its time, and the proposed innovation at Halleybury will bring this time up to a little less than one-fifth.

The problem raised here is not new, but is none the less important. Some day our Boards of Education will give serious consideration to this matter, and doubtless a much greater use will be made of our educational plants. In our cities especially there would be a
