James Murphy, charged with the murder of Mrs. Margaret Brown, who was killed with an axe at her home in Halifax last March, was found not guilty by a Halifax jury yesterday. Archbishop Howley of Newfoundland died last evening aged seventy-one years. He was the first archbishop of the colony. He was also well known as an historian and was prominent in public affairs of the colony. Mrs. Alfred Ayer of Sackville was drowned in a lake near her home yesterday morning. She leaves her husband, two sons and two daughters. Princess Mary has issued an appeal to be made throughout the Empire to have a fund raised to make a suitable present to every soldier and sailor at the front on Christmas eve. Noel Buxton, M. P., and his brother, Charles Roden Buxton, who were in Bulgaria to confer with the government regarding their attitude in the present war, were shot yesterday by a young Turk while on their way to attend the funeral of the late King of Roumania.
