Fables On Health

FOR TREATING BOILS

MANY persons are affected with boils with the coming of spring.

Bad blood may cause them. Also an infection of the skin sometimes will cause a boil.

As soon as a soreness is felt a mixture of camphor and spirits of turpentine should be applied.

Four turpentine on lumps of gum camphor, and bathe the part with the liquid.

When there is much inflammation a flaxseed poultice will give relief.

To make a medium-size flaxseed poultice have a cupful of water boiling in a saucepan and stir in sufficient flaxseed meal, nearly a cupful, to make it stiff enough not to run when spread.

Boil a couple of minutes, and then beat until it is light and spongy. Spread on cotton, leaving enough margin to turn upon the

poultice. Then cover with old muslin.

Another good treatment for boils, if just beginning, is to paint the sore and swollen part with tincture of iodine.

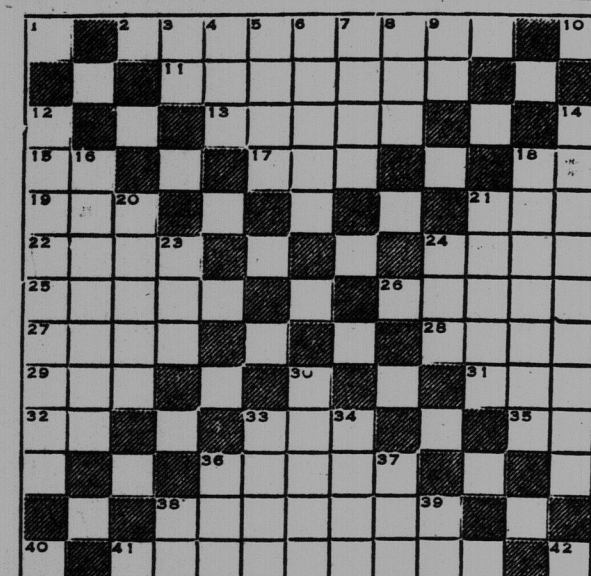
