"Since I issued my last statement concerning Canadian bread conditions, the Canada food board has put into force a regulation which prohibits the wrapping of bread. This regulation, whether or not sought by the bakers, was welcomed by them, and they seem quite content therewith, but in my judgment (admittedly fallible) it conduces to waste and contributes to make higher yet the cost of living. I therefore respectfully suggest that it should be rescinded.






