

BANGOR SAYS MAINE FOREST FIRES RAGING

Penobscot County Has Over Three Thousand Acres Spruce Destroyed.

MACHIAS RIVER LOSS PLACED AT 100,000

Fifteen Hundred Cords of Firewood Burned—Reports of Fire Running Wild.

Bangor, Me., June 10.—Reports reaching Bangor from the Lake Umbagog region in Penobscot County, are to the effect that the forest fires which had been brought under control after burning for five days has taken a fresh start and is raging with increased fury, despite the efforts of 300 men to stop it.

At last accounts the fire had swept over an area two and a half miles by four miles, and not less than 3,000 acres of spruce timber had been destroyed, causing a loss of \$50,000 to \$60,000. More help has been sent from Bangor.
