DAMP CLOSETS.—For a damp closet or cupboard, which is liable to cause mildew, place in it a saucer full of quicklime, and it will not only absorb all apparent dampness, but sweeten and disinfect the place.

To KEEB seeds from the depredations of mice, mix in some pieces of camphor-gum. Camphor placed in drawers or boxes will warn away mice, as well as moths.

AN EXCELLENT SOUP.—An excellent soup can be made by taking one can of corn and boiling the corn in one quart of milk and water in equal proportion; season with salt, pepper, and butter.

THREE KINDS OF CAKE FROM ONE RECIPE.—The housekeeper who is limited as to time and materials will find the following recipe a most excellent one: One pound of flour, one pound of sugar, three-quarters pound of butter, ten eggs.

CRULLERS.—Happy is the woman who can have for use in cooking genuine, freshly-made buttermilk. The following recipe for crullers is a proof of this: Half a pint of buttermilk, a small teaspoonful of butter, two cups of sugar and three eggs.

LADY FINGERS.—Lady fingers made after this recipe are very nice for tea; they should be eaten while fresh: Rub half a pound of butter into a pound of flour; to this add half a pound of sugar, the juice and grated rind of one large lemon, and, lastly, three eggs.

LEMON CUSTARD.—Custard is simply milk thickened with eggs. When a lemon custard is required rub lumps of sugar over the rind of lemons to get the "zest."
